

In support of nursing mothers at UCCS, and in accordance with the Department of Labor, Fair Labor Standards Act, Section 7(r), dated March 23, 2010, the university provides two Lactation Rooms.

- 1. Third floor of the University Center: Please obtain a key from the front desk located on the first floor.
- 2. The ENT Center for the Arts: Private room located in the Women's Restroom on the main floor.
- 3. A third location is planned for the Hybl Sports Medicine & Performance Center

Additionally, departments must provide a private place, other than a bathroom, The Department of Labor guidance is as follows:

Section 7(r) of the Fair Labor Standards Act – Break Time for Nursing Mothers Provision

Effective March 23, 2010, the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act amended the FLSA to require employers to provide a nursing mother reasonable break time to express breast milk after the birth of her child. The amendment also requires that employers provide a place for an employee to express breast milk.

Section 7 of the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938 (29 U.S.C. 207) is amended by adding at the end the following:

(r)(1) An employer shall provide—

- A. A reasonable break time for an employee to express breast milk for her nursing child for 1 year after the child's birth each time such employee has need to express the milk; and
- B. A place, other than a bathroom, that is shielded from view and free from intrusion from coworkers and the public, which may be used by an employee to express breast milk.
